ALI

...so no one can guess your password, and your
info's safe and sound. While on the net,
you've gotta keep yourself switched on.

The superimposed words "SWITCHED ON" appear then fade.

Sprat's dad swims by in the foreground while Sprat continues looking
at the computer screen.

ALI

Before you download anything, check with an
adult you trust.

The superimposed word "TRUST" appears then fades.

Ali swims up to Hector and his friends and then sings to them. Then,
Constable Solosolave pops up.

ALI

Someone who really cares about you will help
you get it searched.

The superimposed words "CARES ABOUT YOU" slide across the screen.

A pop-up has come up on Sprat's computer with the words "ANTIPODES,
*** NEW SONG ***. CLICK HERE to DOWNLOAD a copy of ANTIPODES' latest
song and impress your friends!"

ALI

Some people may try to trick you when you're
online.

Sprat has joined Hector and friends.

ALI

But learn from Hector and his friends, and
you'll be just fine.

The superimposed word "FINE" appears then fades.

Back to the webpage with Ali and his fellow Antipodes performing.

ALI

While on the net you gotta keep yourself
switched on.

The superimposed words "SWITCHED ON" appear then fade.

Sprat hits a key on the keyboard. Ali sings in a 12-paneled screen, then each panel changes to a word being sung. A worm in a robber's mask drops down on a hook.

ALI

You know, there's viruses, loggers, webcam capture and trojans. Spyware, malware, and rootkits, botnets and adware. Phishing and pharming, spamming and worms. Take care. Be aware.

Back to the webpage with Ali and his fellow Antipodes performing.

ALI

Make sure the things on your computer that are important to you...

The superimposed words "IMPORTANT TO YOU" appear then fade.

Ali and the Antipodes sing to Sprat and Ranjeet.

ALI

...are backed up and safely stored away. Here's a clue. Regular back-ups, virus updates are the trick...

The words "REGULAR BACK-UPS", and "VIRUS UPDATES" appear in two panels.

Tama's thought bubble shows a sick computer with a thermometer surrounded by hideous green germs. Sprat opens his eyes wide in wonder.

ALI

...to protect what you care about and keep your computer from getting sick. While on the net you gotta keep yourself switched on.

The superimposed word "SICK" appears then fades.

The superimposed words "SWITCHED ON" slide down the screen.

Ali sings in a 12-paneled screen, then each panel changes to a word being sung. A worm in a robber's mask drops down on a hook.

ALI

Yeah! You know, there's viruses, loggers, webcam capture and trojans. Spyware, malware, and rootkits, botnets and adware. Phishing and

pharming, spamming and worms. Take care. Be aware.

Ali sings on a large screen with the words "ANTIPODES. Live webcast". In front of the screen are his bandmates, Hector and his friends. Tama watches Ali's webcast on a handheld video camera.
