**INTERIOR - UNDERWATER - INSIDE SPRAT'S HOUSE**

WOMAN (VOICEOVER)

You're on the official website of hot new band Antipodes. Website members can be part of a special live concert over the internet from Antipodes much loved hometown Silicon Deep. Not long to go now.

SPRAT'S DAD

Have fun, son. See you soon.

SPRAT

Thanks, Dad. Right.

Sprat pulls out a checklist and proceeds to go through ticking each item.

SPRAT

Dad's large monitor. Check. Internet connection working. Check. OK to have friends around? Check. Food. Check. Dad signs up as viewer? Crikey.

Tama swims in.

TAMA

What are you doing, Sprat?

SPRAT

Dad just logged into the Antipodes website, Tama. He put in a super strong password, but forgot to hit Enter.

Sprat hits Enter. Tama's thought bubble has two muscular arms around the word "password." Various letters of the word "password" then change to include various symbols finally becoming P^S\$W\*RD.

TAMA:

Do you mean his password has big muscles, Sprat?

SPRAT

Well, sort of. Strong passwords help protect things that are important to you.

SPRAT

Dad's password is super strong because it's a mixture of at least eight letters, numbers, and symbols. That makes it hard for someone else to guess. Even your friends.

Tama's thought bubble shows examples of strong passwords "fishdog5", "cool22kid\*", "gr3at\*clam5!".

TAMA

Oh, cool.

SPRAT

You beauty. All logged in and ready to go. I can't wait.

TAMA

What's that?

A flashing pop-up has come up on the computer reading "HELLO! LOOK HERE, AMAZING!".

SPRAT

That's a pop-up window, Tama. You should never trust pop-ups, no matter what they say.

SPRAT

They could link you to all kinds of nasty viruses. Viruses can make your computer very sick.

TAMA

Oh.

Hector swims up.

HECTOR

Tama? Could you please help me with this balloon?

TAMA

Sure, Hector.

Another pop-up comes up on the computer reading "ANTIPODES, NEW SONG!!! CLICK HERE to DOWNLOAD a copy of ANTIPODES' latest song and impress your friends!"

SPRAT

Click here, download a copy of Antipodes' latest song, and impress your friends.

SPRAT

Wow. I could have Antipodes' latest song playing as everyone arrives. How cool would that be?

Sprat hits Enter. The computer begins flashing lights and he gasps.

SPRAT

Uh oh. I probably shouldn't have clicked that.

Static is crackling on the computer.

SPRAT

My mom or dad normally get rid of them for me. But maybe just this once won't hurt?

SPRAT

Oh no. Come on, come on, come on.

Sprat hits Enter repeatedly.

SPRAT

Oh no. What should I do?

Sprat pauses waiting for a viewer response.

SPRAT

Thanks for your suggestions. Now I've got to find someone to help me.

Sprat swims past Hector and Tama. Tama lets go of the balloon, which deflates.

**EXTERIOR - UNDERWATER - DAY**

Sprat swims into a cave with the sign "Tech Cave" above the entrance.

**INTERIOR - UNDERWATER - INSIDE THE TECH CAVE**

Sprat joins Ranjeet and Aretha. Aretha wears headphones and writes notes on a board.

SPRAT

Ranjeet, Aretha.

RANJEET

Sprat, my buddy, my pal. What are you doing here? Shouldn't you be getting ready for the concert?

SPRAT

Ranjeet, I need your help.

RANJEET

No problem. I'll be heading over to your house for the concert shortly. Oh, I'm so excited.

SPRAT

No, Ranjeet, you don't understand. If you don't help me now, there won't be a concert. I've made a big mistake and now the computer isn't working.

RANJEET

Right. We'd better be going. I'll see you later on, Aretha. Bye.

Ranjeet and Sprat are at the computer, which still isn't working. Ranjeet types away.

RANJEET

Hmm. OK. Let's try this one, Sprat. Your dad said he's going to come and help us if my ideas don't work. He said that he copies and backs up the important information on the computer often, because he doesn't want to lose it. It would be like you losing all of the music on your MP3 player.

SPRAT

I can't believe I clicked that pop-up and tried to download that song from a website I didn't know. I'm smarter than that. Now I've ruined everything.

RANJEET

Oh, dear. I think Sprat is a bit upset. What can I say to help him feel better?

Ranjeet pauses for a viewer response.

RANJEET

Thank you, that's very good advice. Sprat? Sprat, my dear friend. Somebody was playing a mean trick, and you made the mistake of falling for it. I'll help you fix it.

SPRAT

Thanks, Ranjeet. You're a good mate.

We hear the chattering of a crowd approaching.

SPRAT

Oh, no. Everyone's here and we haven't got the computer working yet.

Hector and his friends enter.

CONSTABLE SOLOSOLAVE

Woo hoo hoo. Hello there, young Sprat. This is my colleague PC Jim from across the ocean.

PC JIM

Hello everybody.

CONSTABLE SOLOSOLAVE  
He's our visiting expert on cybercrime.

Constable Solosolave whispers to Sprat.

CONSTABLE SOLOSOLAVE  
Your dad told us about your problem.

He returns to address the group.

CONSTABLE SOLOSOLAVE  
Creating and sending harmful viruses is illegal and why anti-virus software is so important.

SPRAT  
Thanks, Constable. And thanks for coming, everyone. But we can't get the computer working, and we're going to miss the concert on the internet. I really let you all down. I'm so sorry.

HECTOR  
It's OK, Sprat. We all brought over our Antipodes music, and we'll have a great time whether we see the concert or not.

Ranjeet continues typing at the computer.

RANJEET  
Just a minute, I'm almost there.

Ali swims up, with his bandmates joining.

ALI  
Mmm. Hello. Does a Sprat live here? Hi, I'm Ali, lead singer of Antipodes. Aretha told us you were a huge fan and your computer had had a meltdown. So we thought we'd drop by and do our concert from your place.

CONSTABLE SOLOSOLAVE  
I've checked with your parents and they're happy. They'll be here soon.

ALI  
Is that cool with you, too, Sprat?

SPRAT

Sure.

ALI

Awesome. You're 'da fish.

Ali and Sprat high-five. Ranjeet finishes type.

RANJEET:

There. All fixed.

ALI

Thanks, Ranjeet.

Ali hands Tama a video camera.

ALI

Here, we need a camera operator.

TAMA

Wow.

Ali and his band have their instruments ready and stand in front of a giant screen.

ALI

Come on, guys. We're live in five, four, three, two--

We pan up to the screen showing the webcast as Antipodes starts to play. Ranjeet pops up when he's referenced as Super Crab.

ALI:

This concert is brought to you live from the house of Sprat and his parents. Some of our biggest fans. And with a big thanks to Super Crab, digital citizen extraordinaire.

The large screen reads "ANTIPODES, LIVE WEBCAST". Antipodes performs. Tama watches the webcast through the video camera.

The credits roll and Sprat swims on-screen with a paper and pencil in hand.

SPRAT

That was so amazing. Thanks for helping me. I guess smart digital citizens always learn from their mistakes. I sure did.
